Dear Resident,

Re: Replacement of new flood and erosion defences along the River Wallington

I am writing to inform you of the upcoming flood and erosion defence replacement works that are due to commence along a stretch of the River Wallington on the 22nd January 2018.

Where is this happening?

The erosion barrier is located either side of the sheet pile wall on the outside bend of the River Wallington, adjacent to 53 Wallington Shore Road.

Why is this happening?

The erosion barrier, which is formed of a gabion basket retaining wall, has reached the end of its serviceable life and is no longer maintainable. It requires replacement to reduce the risk of erosion and to manage the flood risk further upstream at Wallington Village. The works are to be funded by Fareham Borough Council and supervised by the Eastern Solent Coastal Partnership.

What is happening next?

P T Contractors Ltd. has been appointed by Fareham Borough Council to undertake the like-for-like replacement of the erosion barrier. Works are due to commence on **Monday 22nd January 2018** and are expected to take approximately 4 weeks to complete.


Due to the limited amount of space available at this location, a traffic management plan will be implemented to allow for the safe delivery of materials to the site compound adjacent to the works. To minimise disruption to local residents and users of Wallington Shore Road, the traffic management will be removed on completion of each delivery.

Throughout the duration of the works you will see the existing poor conditioned erosion barrier being removed and replaced with a like-for-like gabion basket

retaining wall. These works will happen during daylight hours: 0730-1630, Monday-Friday.
